Voting by Mail is Safe, Easy and Convenient. All registered voters will be mailed an **Official Ballot**, with a postage-paid return envelope beginning February 5, 2024. Return your ballot in the mail, to a Ballot Drop Box or at any Vote Center.



Ballot Drop Box Locations. There will be 56 Ballot Drop Box locations placed throughout the County. View locations at smcvote.gov.



Vote Centers. There will be 45 Vote Centers located throughout the County for in-person voting and voter services. For Vote Center locations and hours, visit smcvote.gov.



Remote Accessible Vote by Mail (RAVBM) System. Vote using the RAVBM System anywhere you have a **computer, printer and internet connection**. View instructions at smcvote.gov.

Sample Ballot and Official Voter Information Pamphlet

Commencing January 25, 2024, the **Sample Ballot and Official Voter Information Pamphlet** will be mailed to every registered voter in San Mateo County and available online at smcvote.gov. The pamphlet provides important information on the **March 5, 2024** Presidential Primary Election and the many voting options available to voters.
