Rebuttal to Argument Against Measure "S" - RCSD (032618)

Ravenswood schools still need our help - vote YES on Measure "S"! Our Facilities Master Plan identified more than \$300 million in needs. Those opposing Measure "S" who do NOT live in Ravenswood - would have our students be satisfied with meeting less than 10% of those needs. We always knew Measure "H" was a first step in the long journey towards providing our students with 17 the schools they deserve. All Ravenswood schools were built over 50 years ago and, until we initiated the facilities planning process in 2014, critical maintenance had been delayed for decades. Measure "H" fixed roofs, began safety improvements and will upgrade science labs – but we still need more resources (6 for many additional repairs and improvements! Vote YES on Measure "S"! 10 We know that resources are not abundant like outsiders claim. Compared to neighboring districts, Ravenswood receives less funding. Indeed, the District is in the process of making many painful budget cuts - so we need the community to continue supporting and investing in our schools. Vote YES on Measure "S"! And just like Measure "H" - which has a tax rate substantially LESS than was promised and will cost 17 taxpayers millions LESS than was expected - we know that Measure "S" is responsible and taxpayer 14 safeguards are in place.
