Argument in Favor of Measure	

This ballot measure will solidify the business license tax on liquid storage facilities in Brisbane. The revenue generated will be up to an approximately \$400,000 per year. The voters of Brisbane first approved a business license tax for liquid storage facilities in 2013. This ballot measure is a result of a lawsuit against the city that was amicably settled by the City and Kinder Morgan. The anticipated revenue to the City is about the same as the previous ballot measure but the method for determining the tax is different. This tax will be on the volume of petroleum product that the Brisbane facility distributes to its customers. Revenue from this source is being used and will continue to be used for general city services such as Police, Fire, Parks and Recreation.
