Rebuttal to the Argument Against Measure N

17 The sole opponent of Measure N doesn't live in our community and has made it his mission to 14 oppose every school measure. Here are the facts: FACT: Measure N is about maintaining the quality of education in San Carlos elementary/ middle schools. FACT: Measure N is on the ballot because there is no other way for San Carlos School District to raise these funds. The San Carlos School District is one of the lowest funded in the State and in 17 San Mateo County. FACT: The quality of San Carlos K-8 schools, teachers, class sizes, and challenging instructional 10 programs depends on local revenue to supplement limited State funding. 12 FACT: San Carlos School District is among the highest achieving districts in the state despite 11 having significantly less funding per student then our neighboring districts. Student 14 achievement has increased significantly from 2015 to 2019 (Math: 69% increased to 75% & 7 English/Language Arts: 74% increased to 79%). FACT: Measure N is prudent, asking for less money than neighboring districts. Measure N expires in eight years and cannot be renewed without voter approval. 11 FACT: ALL Measure N funds stay local to benefit San Carlos schools and students only. NO funds 15 are allowed for administrators' salaries or pensions. 22 Don't be deceived by the opponent's inaccurate and misleading statements.
