AN ORDINANCE OF THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF COLMA AMENDING THE COLMA MUNICIPAL CODE TO MAKE THE CITY TREASURER AN APPOINTIVE OFFICE

The People of the Town of Colma do ordain as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Colma Municipal Code Section 1.03.100 Amended.

Section 1.03.100 of the Town of Colma Municipal Code shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

1.03.100 City Treasurer.

The City Treasurer shall be appointed by the City Council of the Town of Colma. The duties of the City Treasurer shall be those now or hereafter fixed by the laws of the State of California, and by the City Council.

ARTICLE 2. Effective Date.

- (a) This Ordinance is subject to a vote of the citizens of Colma and, if approved by a majority of the voters voting at such election, shall be deemed adopted by the City Council on the date the vote is canvassed and declared official by the City Council, and shall be effective 30 days thereafter.
- (b) The first appointment of City Treasurer made pursuant to this Ordinance shall not occur until the term of the City Treasurer in office on the effective date of this Ordinance expires, or is vacated.
- **ARTICLE 3. Summary.** Following the City Clerk's certification that the citizens of Colma have approved this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign this Ordinance and the City Clerk shall cause the same, or a summary thereof, to be published as required by law.
