A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE COASTSIDE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TO THE SAN MATEO COUNTY OFFICE OF ELECTIONS DECLARING THAT FOR THE RECALL ELECTION SET FOR APRIL 9, 2013, CANDIDATES' STATEMENTS BE LIMITED TO 200 WORDS AND CANDIDATES' STATEMENTS BE PAID FOR BY THE CANDIDATES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code Section 11225, petitions for the recall of Director Michael Alifano, Director A. Douglas Mackintosh and Director Gary Riddell were found to be sufficient, and the Chief Elections Officer certified the results of the examination to the Board at its November 28, 2012, meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors accepted the certifications as submitted and has now set a special election for April 9, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Elections Official has requested that the Board determine how many words will be allowed in candidates' statements and who will pay for those statements; and

WHEREAS, the District has a past practice of allowing 200 words in candidate statements and requesting candidates to bear the cost associated with those statements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors for the Coastside Fire Protection District that:

- Candidate statements for the April 9, 2013 special election shall be limited to 200 words.
 - 2. Candidates shall be responsible for the costs of candidate statements.
- 3. The Board of Directors authorizes the Clerk of the Board to file a copy of this resolution with the San Mateo County Chief Elections Officer.
