## Argument in Favor of Measure DD



Preschool for All in South San Francisco, Vote YES on DD!

- A) South San Francisco's existing preschool programs are universally praised as valuable resources for families. However, they are very expensive for families raising young children, and there's not enough space to serve every child. In fact, there is a consistent 4-year waitlist of 700 families for the City's public preschool programs. That means many parents with young children must choose between their career or paying more than \$1,500 a month, per child, for private preschool.
- B) Further, preschool teachers and staff are currently not paid a living wage, leading to a shortage of teachers and caregivers for children in our city.
- C) Studies show that attending preschool improves school performance, leads to higher graduation rates, higher incomes later in life, and lowers incarceration rates. The South San Francisco Childcare Master Plan states that for every \$1 we invest in preschool we receive \$8.60 in societal benefits.
