Measure Y - Transacations and Use (Sales) Tax Measure

"California has a \$97 BILLION surplus and Pacifica revenues have never been higher, but Pacifica Councilmembers think you're rich and dumb. Vote "NO ON MEASURE Y" the "TRANSACTIONS AND USE (SALES) TAX MEASURE"

Not just a tax increase, it's a new category of tax that follows you around California. Whether you buy a Tesla (\$690 Measure Y tax) in Fremont, a Prius (\$160 Measure Y tax) in Colma, or an iPhone (\$40 Measure Y tax) online, you can't escape it, and **ONLY PACIFICANS PAY THIS TAX**.

Councilmember's biggest spend last year was the midnight-approved \$12M "Showpiece City Hall Rennovation"- there's no guarantee Councilmembers won't use the money for widening Highway 1, dismantling the Sharp Park Seawall, shoehorning six story apartments into the Rockaway Quarry, or paying more debt.

Pacifica Councilmembers clearly have a spending problem, more of YOUR money won't fix that. You can't live beyond your means and neither should your City Council.

The 2020 Sales Tax rate was 9.250%, 9.375% in 2021 and now Councilmembers want a third increase in two years to 9.875%. That's the highest tax rate in San Mateo County and only Palo Alto in Santa Clara County pays more.
