MEASURE T REBUTTAL

VOTE NO on Measure T, to ensure that the South San Francisco
Unified School District Board of Trustees does not abuse the public
trust again, which happened after Measure J was approved by voters.

VOTE NO to reaffirm to the Board of Trustees that voters are aware that they are responsible for failure to properly repair and maintain $\geq \lambda$ District properties, not taxpayers.

VOTE NO to inform the Board that when Measure J was approved by voters, repairs and upgrades should have been made with those funds. \$25 million was wasted on a District wide solar power project, instead of being invested to repair and maintain existing facilities.

VOTE NO to convey to the Board that voters will not tolerate the same type of misuse of public funds, which occurred when Measure J funds were spent improperly.

VOTE NO to advise the Board that they should not have disregarded the advice and recommendations by the Measure J Bond Oversight Committee. What good is an oversight committee that has no authority and is ignored by the Board of Trustees?

VOTE NO to ensure that the Board of Trustees does not incur a billion-dollar debt for current and future taxpayers. SSFUSD property tax payments are already some of the highest in the country and we still have 30 years to pay for Measure J.

VOTE NO so the Board of Trustees will know that taxpayers are tired of their incompetence and refuse to continue funding their mistakes.
