Argument Against the San Mateo Community College District \$388,000,000 Bond <u>Issue: Measure H</u>

10	Measure-H will saddle the District with huge new debt.				
138	To service the loans and pay them back, San-Mateo Community College District must either divert existing revenues being used for education services, or force all property owners in the district to pay more taxes.				
15193	Servicing debt isn't cheap. A 3% interest rate on a \$388,000,000 bond means paying \$11,640,000 in annual interest for 25-30 years. The total cost of the bond measure in today's dollars? \$679,000,000 – more if not paid back in the first 25 years.				
	The District says it needs \$388,000,000 to "upgrade computer, biotechnology and job training facilities."
