Rebuttal to the Argument Against Measure A

Neither of Measure A's two opponents live in Millbrae and one doesn't even live in San Mateo County. Why are they meddling with local funding for Millbrae students and teachers by touting misleading facts and hollow arguments?

We've all raised our families, taught local children or served our community here in Millbrae and we're proud to support Measure A.

Here's why:

Measure A renews an <u>existing</u> source of local funding that is set to expire. It replaces Measure N before that funding disappears, with a modest increase of less than \$2.50 per month. For seniors 65 and older, there's an exemption from Measure A so that cost is never a barrier to supporting Millbrae's schools.

Without Measure A, our schools are facing deep cuts. If Measure A fails, Millbrae School District will be forced to lay off teachers, increase class sizes and cut academic programs.

Strict fiscal accountability keeps every penny of Measure A in Millbrae schools and away from the State. Citizens' oversight and annual audits have continually confirmed that Millbrae School District has spent voter-approved funding as intended.
