## Rebuttal to Argument Against Measure V

Our parks and open space make San Carlos a special place to live. A Yes vote on Measure V answers one critical question: do we want a park on Black Mountain, or 100 more homes and traffic?

Measure V gives us the rare opportunity to permanently protect beautiful open space right in the path of development in the nation's hottest region for real estate—an investment in maintaining the neighborhood balance we value in San Carlos. Not a penny more than what voters authorize can be spent, and less if possible. Funds can only be used to create a park on Black Mountain.

We must act now to protect San Carios' few remaining natural areas before they are gone forever.
