A rebuttal argument shall not be accepted unless accompanied by this completed form, which shall contain the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the person(s) submitting it or, if submitted on behalf of a bona fide association of citizens/organization, the name of the association/organization and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers.

<u>Jefferson Union School District \$60 Parcel Tax:</u> Rebuttal to the Argument in Favor of Measure E

This tax increase from Jefferson Union High School District is using the state budget crisis to grab unearned money. The district wants to increase and "extend" (read: increase) the 2012 parcel tax of \$48/year for another 10 years, and hike it to \$60 per year — just when we thought we would get a tax cut, we get a tax hike!

With <u>declining enrollment</u>, has the district *earned* this extension costing our households another \$600 each?

Let's look at student test scores:

2012-13 English results:

56% met proficiency

2012-13 Mathematics:

25% met proficiency

2012-13 Science:

55% met proficiency

2012–13 History:

51% met proficiency

If you got 25–56% of the answers right on a test, that would be a failing grade, would it not?

Should we, the voters, reward a 44-75% failure rate?

If you answered "no," we encourage you to vote NO on Measure £.

The average expense per student statewide is \$10,194 per year, versus Jefferson Union High School District's \$10,374, or 102% of the statewide average. Yet, they want more of your hard-earned money to pad their salaries and fat pension plans.

Most school districts' parcel tax measures state, "None of the funds will be used for administration." But, that wording is missing from Measure E. That means funds WILL be used for administration expenses without limits.

Tell Jefferson Union High School District to be financially responsible, by voting **NO on Measure E.**
