Argument Against Measure C

Measure C is a hidden tax on Pacificans. Save your money and Vote No.

Economic experts project that Measure C will really cost Pacifica closer to \$2,000,000 to administer and defend. Yet, the tax in Measure C generates only \$500,000. The \$1,500,000 shortage will likely come from our general fund – taking money from vital city services – like our streets, police, fire, and parks. Vote No.

Measure C creates a huge new government bureaucracy in Pacifica, accountable to no one. An unelected government bureaucracy (Rental Housing Commission) will be created to impose fees, make new laws, hire new employees, and spend taxpayer money, with zero accountability to voters. The City of Pacifica is in dire financial shape. To pay for Measure C, either the new bureaucracy triples the hidden tax without voter approval or the City cuts vital programs and services.
