## Instructions for Completion of Statement Withdrawal from a Partnership Operating under a Fictitious Business Name

## Section 17923 Business & Professions Code

- (c) The statement of withdrawal from the partnership operating under a fictitious business name shall be published in the same manner as the fictitious business name statement (as described in Section 17924 Business & Professions Code below) and an affidavit showing the publication of the statement shall be filed with the county clerk after the completion of the publication.
- (d) The withdrawal of a general partner does not cause a fictitious business name statement to expire if the withdrawing partner files a statement of withdrawal meeting the requirements of this section.

## Section 17924 Business & Professions Code

- (1) Your fictitious business name statement must be published in a newspaper once a week for four successive weeks and an affidavit of publication filed with the county clerk when publication has been accomplished. The statement should be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the county where the principal place of business is located. The statement should be published in such county in a newspaper that circulates in the area where the business is to be conducted. (Business and Professions Code Section 17917)
- (2) Any person who executes, files, or publishes any fictitious business name statement, knowing that such statement is false, in whole or in part, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

  (Business and Professions Code Section 17930)
