Project Title: Tree Preservation Ordinance

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Ordinance would repeal and replace Ch. 12 (Preservation of Heritage Trees) and Ch. 14 (Maintenance and Preservation of City Trees) within Title 4 of the Pacifica Municipal Code. Ordinance would, update various definitions including the definition of a "heritage" tree and grove of trees; create a new definition for "protected" tree; and require tree protection plans from developers for tree impacts. The Ordinance would also prohibit certain activities relating to protected trees including affixing signs to or topping of any "protected" tree and require a tree removal permit removal of a "protected" tree.

Reasons why project is exempt:

The current regulations include provisions for the preservation of trees that have a trunk with a circumference of 50" (approximately 16" in diameter) or more, measured at 24" above the natural grade. This Ordinance would expand local regulations to apply to a broader size range and criteria of trees, including trees that have a trunk with a diameter of 12" or greater, thereby increasing the number of existing trees that would be protected and preserved. The project would also add specific standards for tree pruning and encroachment within 50' of a tree that has a trunk with a diameter of 12" or greater thereby expanding the preservation efforts for existing trees. Furthermore, this Ordinance would reduce the criteria that could be used to grant the approval of a tree removal and adds a requirement for replacement trees for the removal of healthy trees at a ratio of 2:1, which will result in fewer existing trees being removed, and more new trees planted. Given these expanded regulations, the Ordinance would enhance rather than degrade existing environmental conditions and will increase preservation of existing trees. Therefore, it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that this project may have a significant effect on the environment.
