The Option to “Go Green! Go Paperless!”

As part of our continuing effort to use our resources wisely, we now offer every voter the option to receive the Sample Ballot & Official Voter Information Pamphlet electronically, rather than by postal mail. The voter will access the pamphlet with a web link that we issue by email.

All pamphlets are available in English, Spanish or Chinese.

After signing up only once to participate in the program, the voter will not receive a paper pamphlet for future elections until the voter notifies us, at any time, to resume delivery of the paper pamphlet.

In multi-voter households, members may choose to share one paper pamphlet. Every voting member of the household—except for one—will sign up for the program.

Here's how the program works:

- When you sign up to Go Green, you give us your email address.
- We store your email address in a secure, separate database that is used solely for the purposes of this program. Your email address will not be shared with any third party.
Note: Your email address is not added to our master voter registration database, which contains information from your voter registration card. State law allows us to sell voter registration data to a short list of authorized users, such as political campaign committees. However, if you provided an email address on your voter registration card, it will be included with the voter registration data that we sell
- Before the election, we will use your email address to send you an internet link. The link will connect you to our web site where you can download your assigned pamphlet in PDF format:
 - Click on “Check My Registration/Election Information”
 - Fill in the online form: your house number, your ZIP code, and your birth date

There are three easy ways to sign up to Go Green:

1 — Online at www.shapethefuture.org

On the home page of the official elections web site, click on the Go Green banner to find the fill-in application form; or

2 — Check the box on your Vote by Mail return envelope:

If you are a Vote by Mail voter, fill in the checkbox on the outside of your ballot return envelope (“Yes, sign me up to receive my voter pamphlet online”) and write in your email address; or

3 — Complete the form on your current Pamphlet:

Find the request form at the bottom of the back cover. Fill it in and sign it. Return it to the Elections Office by mail, fax, email, or in person, as directed on the form.
